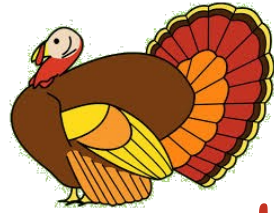

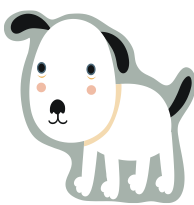
We would like to thank all the families for their part in our Fall Harvest Celebration. It was a huge success!

Try at Home:

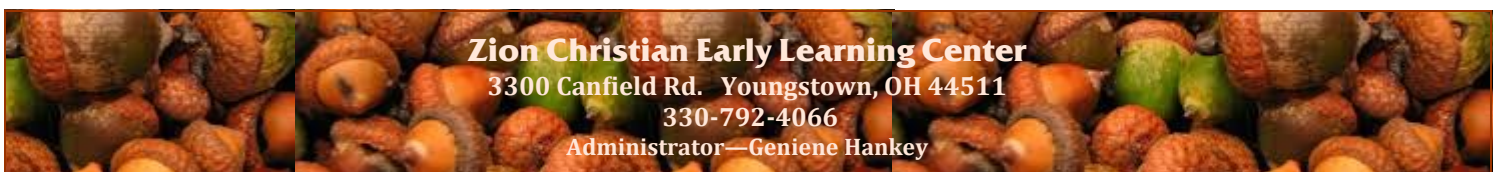
Family Reading Time
